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## PAL OF HALLANDALE BEACH BACKGROUND CHECK CRITERIA

### Criteria for Exclusion

A person will be disqualified and prohibited from serving as a volunteer if the person has been found guilty of the following crimes:

For purpose of this policy; *Guilty* shall mean that a person was found guilty following a trial, entered a guilty plea, entered a no contest plea accompanied by a court finding of guilt (regardless of adjudication), or received court directed programs in lieu of conviction.

Any event worker, vendor, staff member, coach or volunteer of The Police Athletic League of Hallandale Beach who:

- (1) Has been convicted of a violent felony or conspiracy to commit a violent felony within the past five (5) years; or
- (2) Has been convicted of a felony involving the trafficking of a controlled substance within the past (5) years; or
- (3) Has two (2) or more convictions for a violent felony, for conspiracy to commit a violent felony, or involving the trafficking of a controlled substance; or
- (4) All Sex Offenses – regardless of the amount of time since offense; or
- (5) Any misdemeanor within the past 5 years that would be considered a potential danger to children or is directly related to the functions of that volunteer.

*Sex Offenses* shall refer to: child molestation, rape, sexual assault, sexual battery, sodomy, prostitution, solicitation, indecent exposure, etc.

*Violent felony* shall refer to the following felonies: arson; sexual battery; robbery; kidnapping; aggravated child abuse; aggravated abuse of an elderly person or disabled adult; aggravated assault with a deadly weapon; murder; manslaughter; aggravated manslaughter of an elderly person or disabled adult; aggravated manslaughter of a child; unlawful throwing, placing, or discharging of a destructive device or bomb; armed burglary; aggravated battery; or aggravated stalking.

### **PENDING CASES:**

Anyone who has been charged for any of the disqualifying offenses or for cases pending in court will not be permitted to volunteer until the official adjudication of the case.
